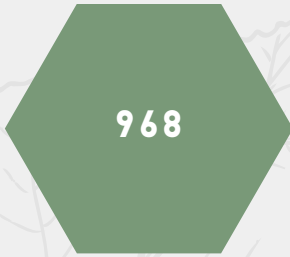

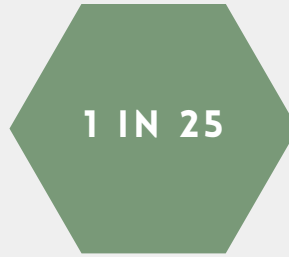

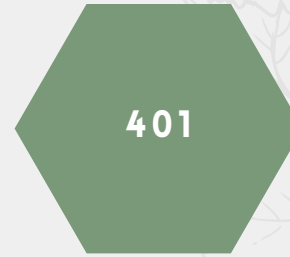

Despite another full year of COVID-19 outbreaks, cancellations, and social distancing, CP’s programs continued serving families throughout 2021. Some programs operated at a reduced capacity serving fewer families than usual, while other programs served significantly more families than during a typical year. Overall, CP served roughly the same number of individuals in 2021 as in a typical year (approximately 1,000), adapting its services to meet unprecedented community need.

During the last quarter of 2021, CP purchased a vacant building and relocated to its new location. The building remains under construction as program spaces are remodeled, but thanks to partners who continue to generously share their spaces, CP programs and services have experienced little disruption due to the relocation and remodel.

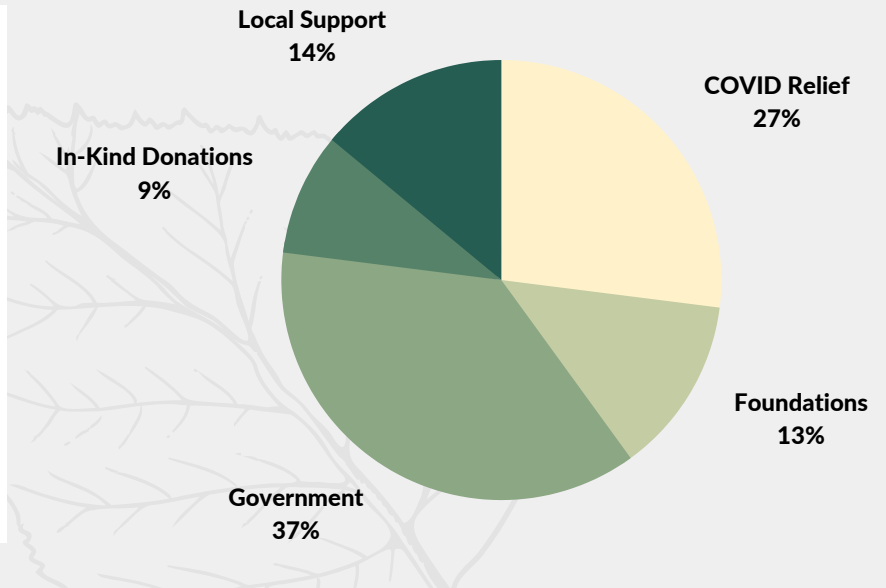

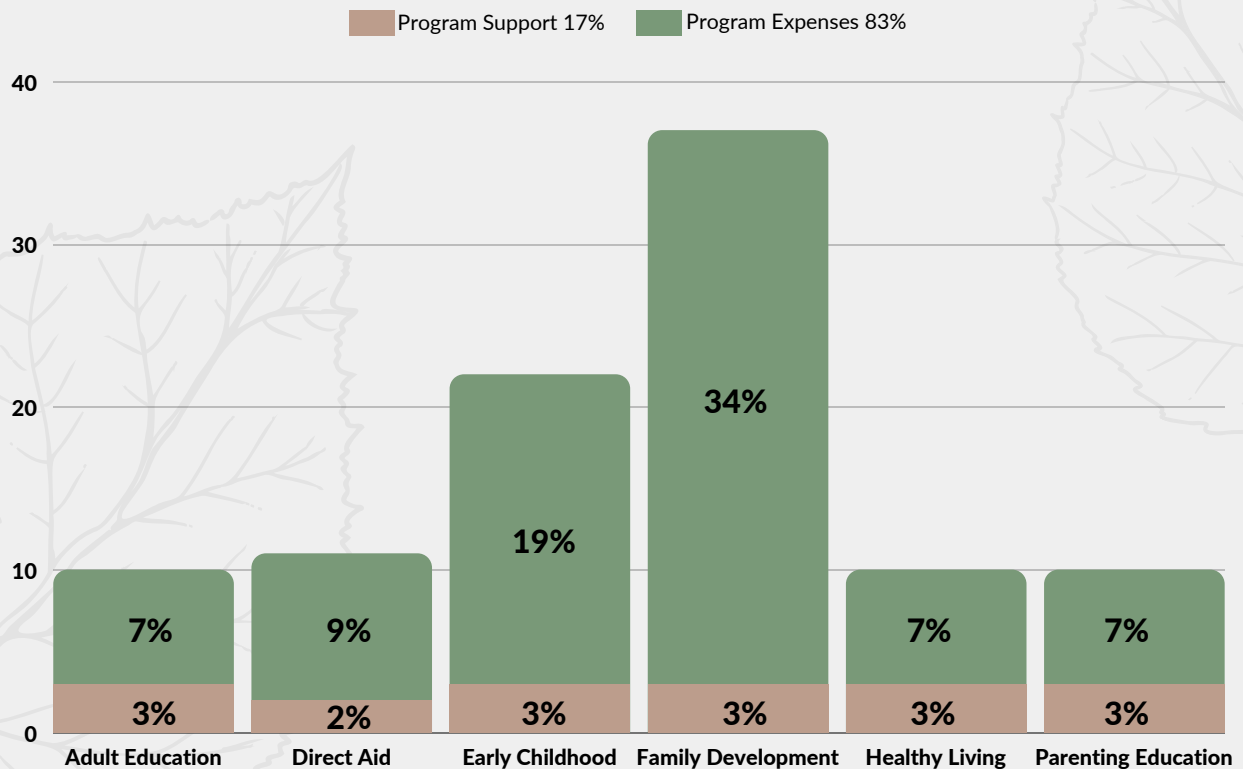

# RETURN ON INVESTMENT OF A FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER TO THE CHILD WELFARE SYSTEM: COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP FAMILY RESOURCE CENTER, TELLER COUNTY, CO

**FOR EVERY \$1 INVESTED IN COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP IN 2018, THE TELLER COUNTY CHILD WELFARE SYSTEM SAVED AN ESTIMATED \$2.92.**

In this report, the OMNI Institute quantified the savings to the child welfare system for Teller County, Colorado from investment in Community Partnership Family Resource Center (CPFRC). CPFRC is the sole FRC that serves Teller County, and after beginning a formal partnership with the local child welfare system, there was a **63% reduction in the rate of child abuse in the county.**

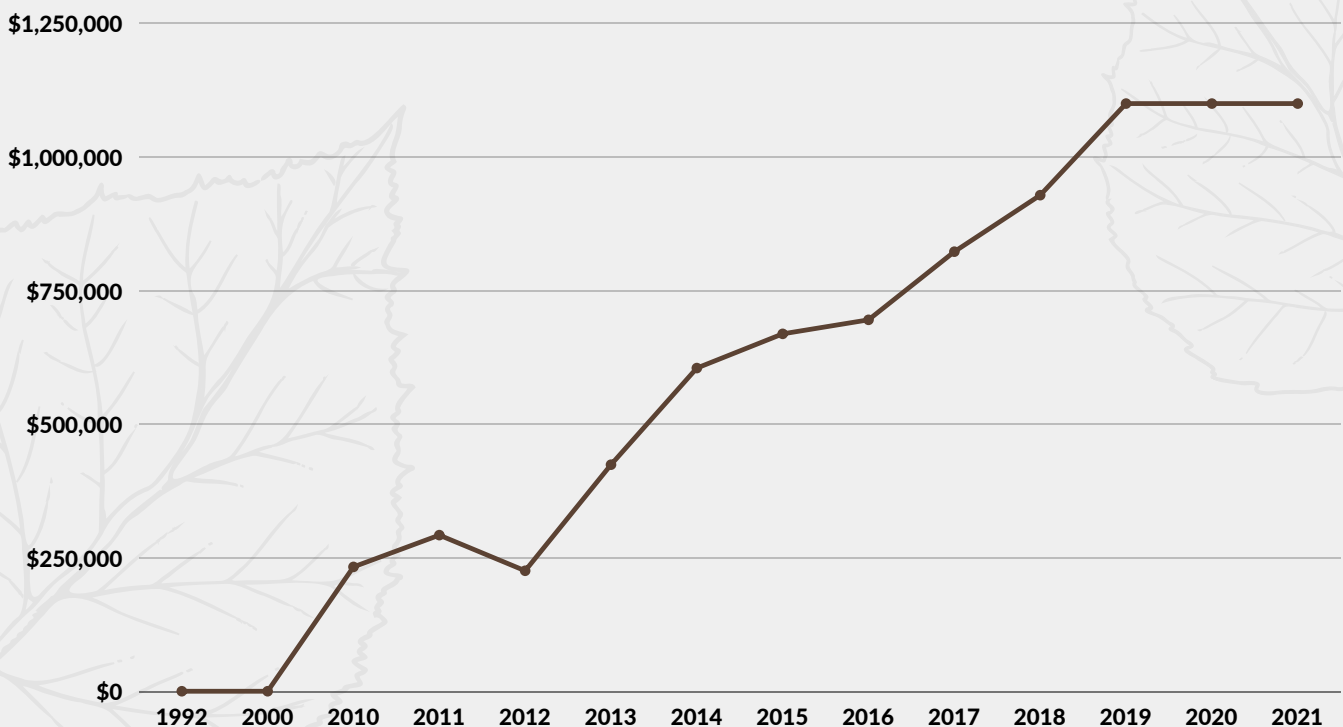

Community Partnership Family Resource Center announces its Capital Campaign and enhanced community focus! As an agency whose mission is to provide programs and experiences which sustain the families in our community, we are taking the lead on BUILDING our county's ONLY Community Center, complete with a conference room, family rooms, multi-purpose space for large group activities, and a learning kitchen and Parent Café. Spaces will be used to host CP's adult exercise classes, playgroups, parenting workshops, cooking classes, gardening workshops, adult education and GED classes, and will be shared with partners and community members. The project provides a welcoming place for families to congregate and build a lasting network of support.

CP is half-way to the goal of funding the project thanks in part to the early support of the El Pomar Foundation, Newmont Cripple Creek & Victor Mine and Park State Bank & Trust.

**GOAL: \$1,235,000**



The largest contribution to the project so far has been from the CP Board of Directors. Together they have contributed over \$100,000 to the project! The entire project cost is \$1,235,000 and CP has already raised \$620,000 toward that.
