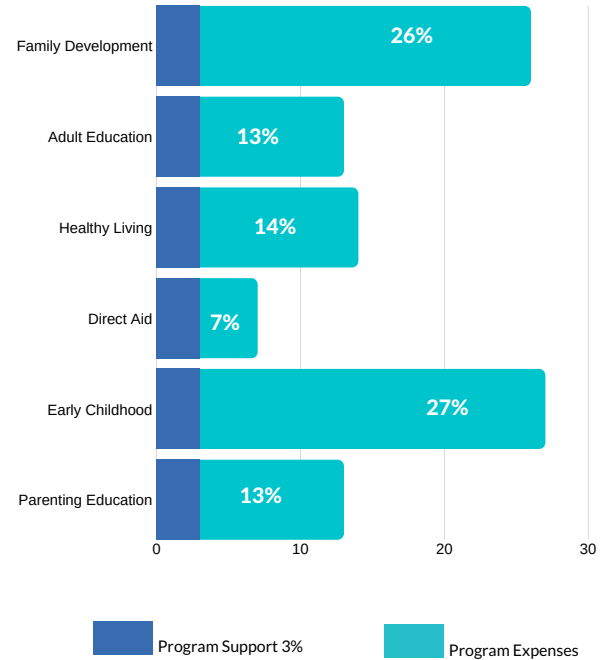
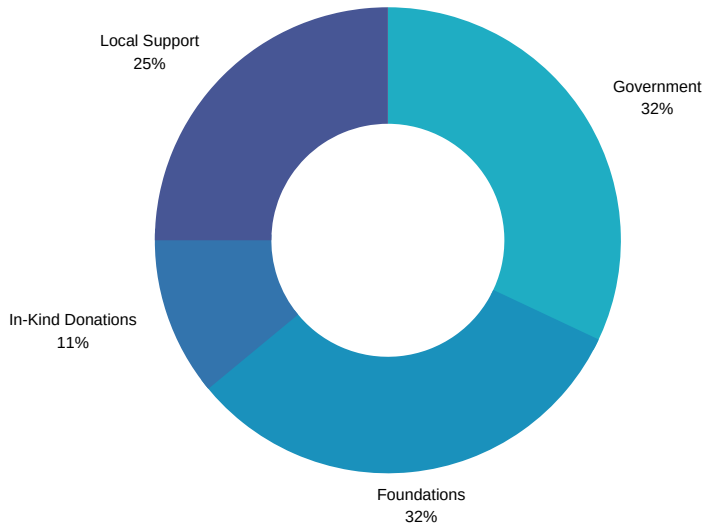

All Teller County families are self-reliant, fully functional, and positive contributors to our community.

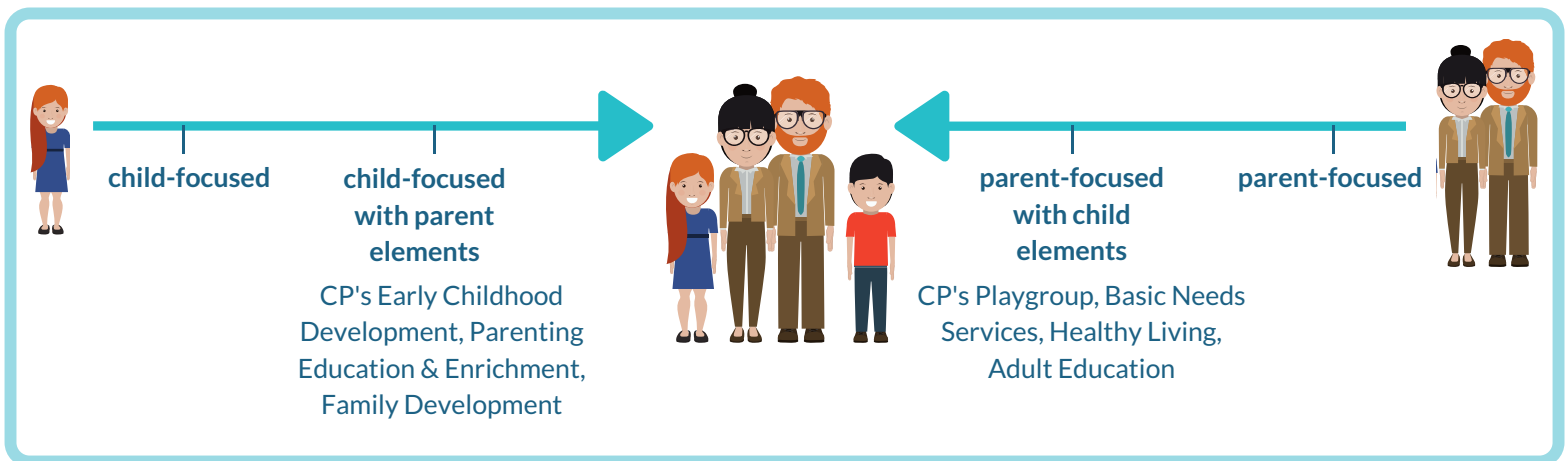
2018 TOTAL REVENUE AND SUPPORT: \$1,102,126

The Two-Generation Continuum

CP utilizes the **Two-Generation Continuum** in all its programs and services. It focuses on creating opportunities for and addressing needs of both children and the adults in their lives together. The continuum recognizes that families come in all different shapes and sizes and that families define themselves. This approach ensures families are strengthened in the **Five Protective Factors: Parental Resilience, Knowledge of Parenting and Child Development, Concrete Supports in Times of Need, Children's Social and Emotional Development, and Social Connections**. This results in family stability and stronger community engagement.

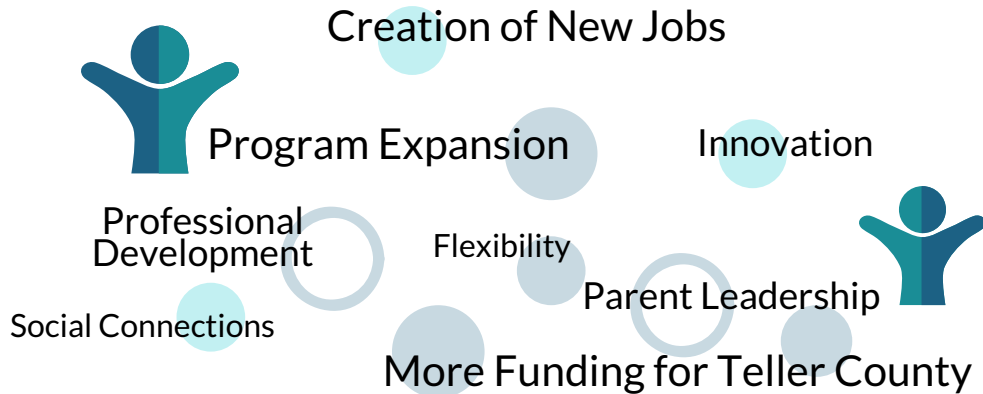

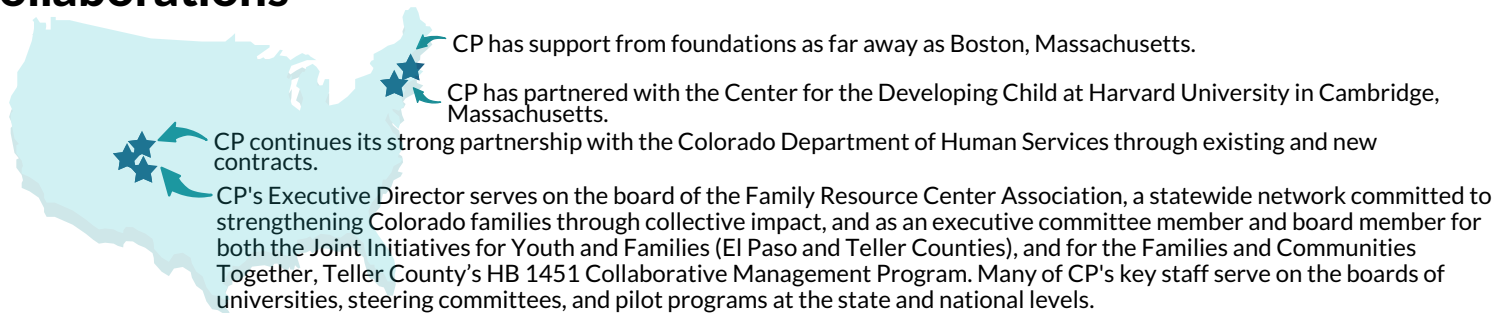

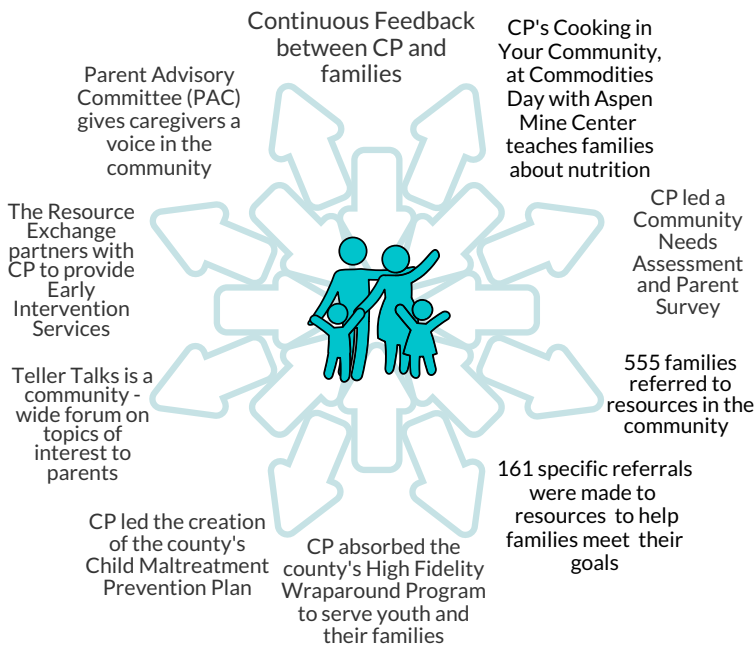
Did You Know??

Collaborations



CP has focused on delivering a deeper level of coordinated care through family development services. In 2018, 195 families, with guidance from CP Family Advocates (FAs), were provided with customized family development plans, goal-setting, financial coaching, basic needs assistance, and referrals to CP's services and to other external providers.



The total number of unduplicated families served in 2018 was 722. While the number of individuals served (1,351) did not change from 2017, many service numbers increased in 2018, indicating an increase in cross-program participation across CP services.
